- What is allowed: blankets, stadium seats, medical assistance devices, baby food (with child in arms), small clutch, clear bag

- Bag Valet located on top of Peters parking deck and at the corner of Techwood and North Ave.

Concessions available at all ceremonies



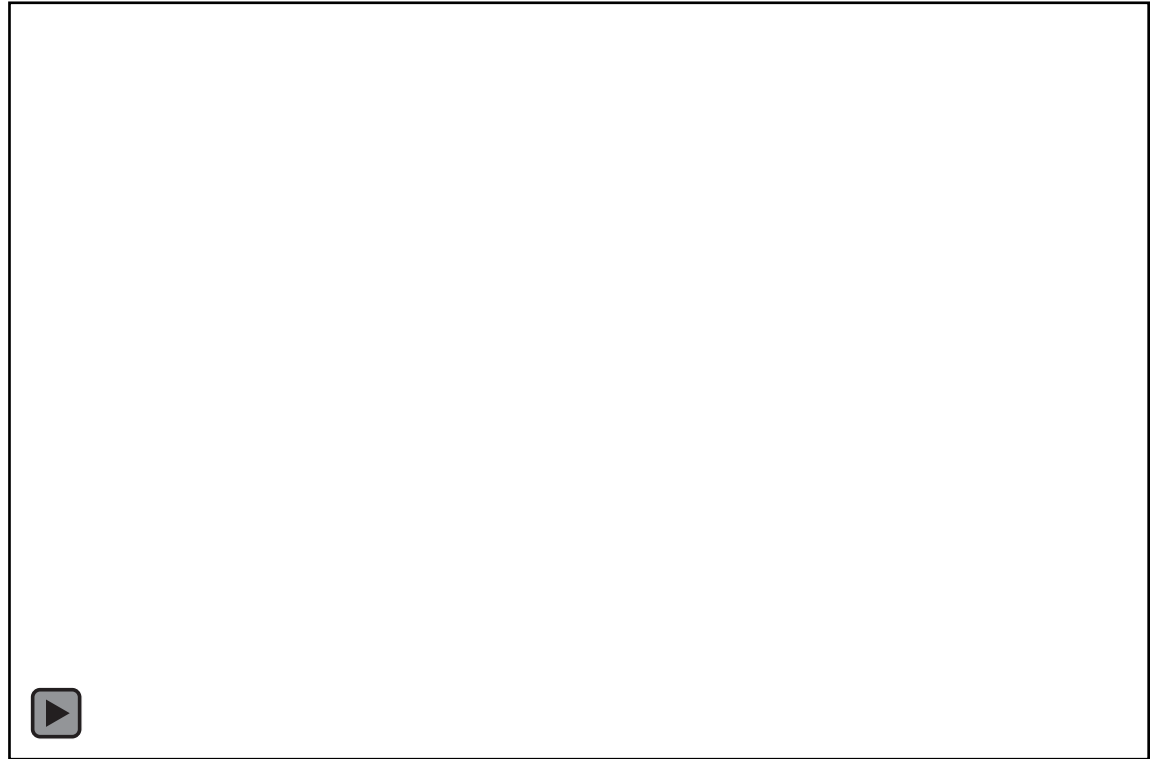
Blue ticket required for wheelchair seats; Limited to one companion.
